By means of this document exercises their right to restriction on processing, in accordance with the provisions in article 17 of Regulation (EU) 2016/679 by the European Parliament and of the Council of 27 April 2016 on the protection of natural persons with regard to the processing of personal data and on the free movement of such data (GDPR), and

REQUESTS,

1. That SCALPERS FASHION S.L.'s proceeds to restrict processing of the personal data of the data subject (or on behalf of the represented subject) for the following reason:

- The data subject challenges the accuracy of the personal data and requests it to be blocked while SCALPERS FASHION S.L. verifies its accuracy.
- The data subject considers that the processing is illicit and requests restriction on its use.
- The controller no longer needs the personal data for processing purposes, but the data subject needs it for the formulation, exercise or defence of claims.
- The data subject has objected to the processing of data by virtue of article 21 of the GDPR, section 1, while it is verified if the legitimate reasons of the controller prevail over those of the data subject.

That, both in the case of accepting or denying the exercise of erasure, SCALPERS FASHION S.L. proceeds to send the resolution in writing, within a period of one month, by:

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2. That if the erased data had been passed on or transferred previously, SCALPERS FASHION S.L. notifies about the restriction on the processing to those it has been passed on to, in accordance with the provisions in article 19 of the GDPR.

3. That the data subject is informed by SCALPERS FASHION S.L. prior to the lifting of that restriction.

The form, duly filled in, must be submitted accompanied by a photocopy of the National Identity Number or equivalent document that proves the identity of the data subject and that is considered legally valid. In the case of acting through a legal representative, the National Identity Number of the representative and proof of them representing the data subject must be provided.
